Guidelines for submitting a Students' Forum abstract

Students' Forum is a new type of a session at ISCI conference, lasting 90 minutes. Students, early-career researchers, policy makers and practitioners are invited to give a **single-authored 3-minutes speech** on a topic that is relevant to the conference theme.

Novel and original ideas and future visions ("*the touch of change*") are most encouraged.

- The author should register at <https://www.conftool.pro/iscii2019/>
- On the "Your Submissions" page, choose "Students' Forum" and follow the proceeding instructions.
- The abstract (up to 250 words) should (1) explain the relevance of the speech to the conference theme (with the focus on the "*time and touch of change*"); (2) include main message the author would like to share, and (3) why this abstract should be accepted by the Program Committee.
- The author should provide a 50-75 word biography

The Students' Forum is competition-based. The best presentation will be announced during the conference dinner.
