Guidelines for submitting a panel presentation

A panel presentation is a session, lasting 90 minutes, organized by applicants. It includes three to five papers that address a common theme and includes at least three presenting authors.

- All contributing authors should register at <https://www.conftool.pro/iscii2019/>
- While all authors will have access to the process and receive confirmation of the submission, one author should be chosen to manage the abstract submission process (ie. all following steps).
- On the "Your Submissions" page, choose "Panel Presentation" and follow the proceeding instructions.
- Names, email addresses and organizational affiliations of all contributing authors should be included on the application.
- The group will choose one domain (research, policy or practice), up to two main themes and up to three topics (listed at <http://www.iscii2019.org/call-for-abstracts/>). The domain, themes and topics should represent the session, rather than just one paper.
- The title of the submission should reflect the overarching theme of the session, rather than a single presentation.
- The submission should include 1) an abstract identifying the overarching topic and main components of the panel (150 words), and 2) 4 to 5 individual abstracts (350-500 words each).
- Authors should write individual abstracts for each presentation in the session (eg. three presenting authors = three abstracts). However, all abstracts should be included in one joint submission (ie. submit the text of all abstracts in the 'Abstract' box on ConfTool).
- Each contributing author should provide a 50-75 word biography
